IMIPORTANT NOTICE:


- * DO NOT OVER-TIGHTEN SCREWS.
- * USE A IDIRIILL WITH AIDJUSTABLE TORQUE FOR BEST RESULTS.
- * OVER-TIGHTENING MAY RESULT IN STRIPPING OUT THE PILOT HOLE, AND SCREW MAY "SINK" INTO THE PLASTIC WHICH MAY CAUSE A STRESS FRACTURE.




Step 1: Take Panel A and place it in the vertical position, align panel B with panel A in the vertical position making sure the rail aligns with the top and the bottom. Slide the rails in a downward motion until they are even. Make sure the holes in the rails are aligned.




Step 2: Take Panel C place it in the vertical position, aligning it with Panel B. Slide the rail of panel C in a downward motion and align the holes in the rail.



Step 3: Take Panel D place it in the vertical position, aligning it with Panels A and C. Slide the rail of panel D in a downward motion and align the holes in the rail.




Step 4: Place board G in the proper alignment with the top, middle and bottom rails carefully aligning the holes in the rails with the pilot holes in board G. Once you have the holes aligned insert (1) - One #12 x 2-1/2"- Pan Head Phillips Screw per hole of the TOP RING ONLY and (1) - One #12 x 2-1/4" - Pan Head Phillips Screw per hole in the bottom and middle rings. Make sure both screws are all the way in and tight on the top rail before moving to the middle rail. Once you have gone all the way around the top and middle rails, flip the trash can up-side-down and repeat the previous steps to complete the bottom rail. (Note: Please be careful to not over-tighten the screws.)



Step 5: If you would like to take advantage of the supplied Lid Lanyard, just remove the desired screw from the top rail and re-secure it with the lanyard attached.

(Just remove the screw in the lid if you would like to forgo the use of the Lid Lanyard.)

Step 6: Finally, put the liner in the receptacle as shown and place the lid on the top rail with the lanyard on the underside (if attached).
