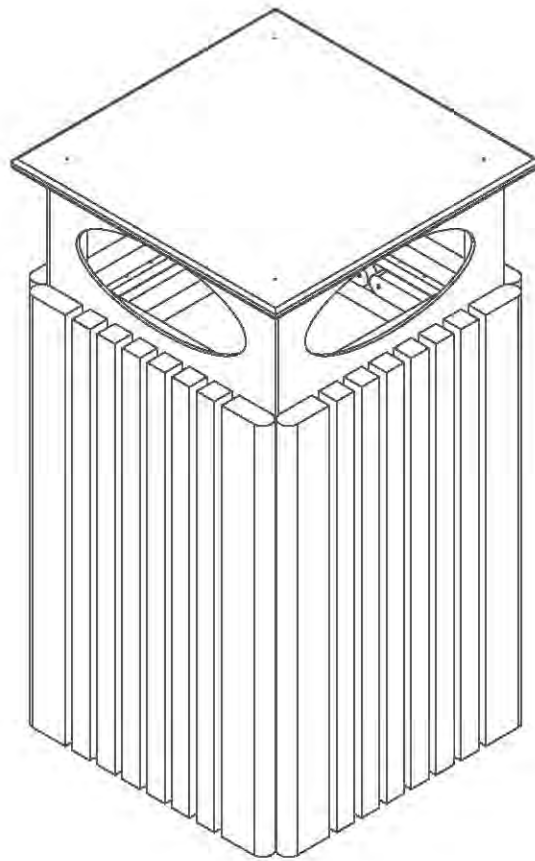

With Rain Cap

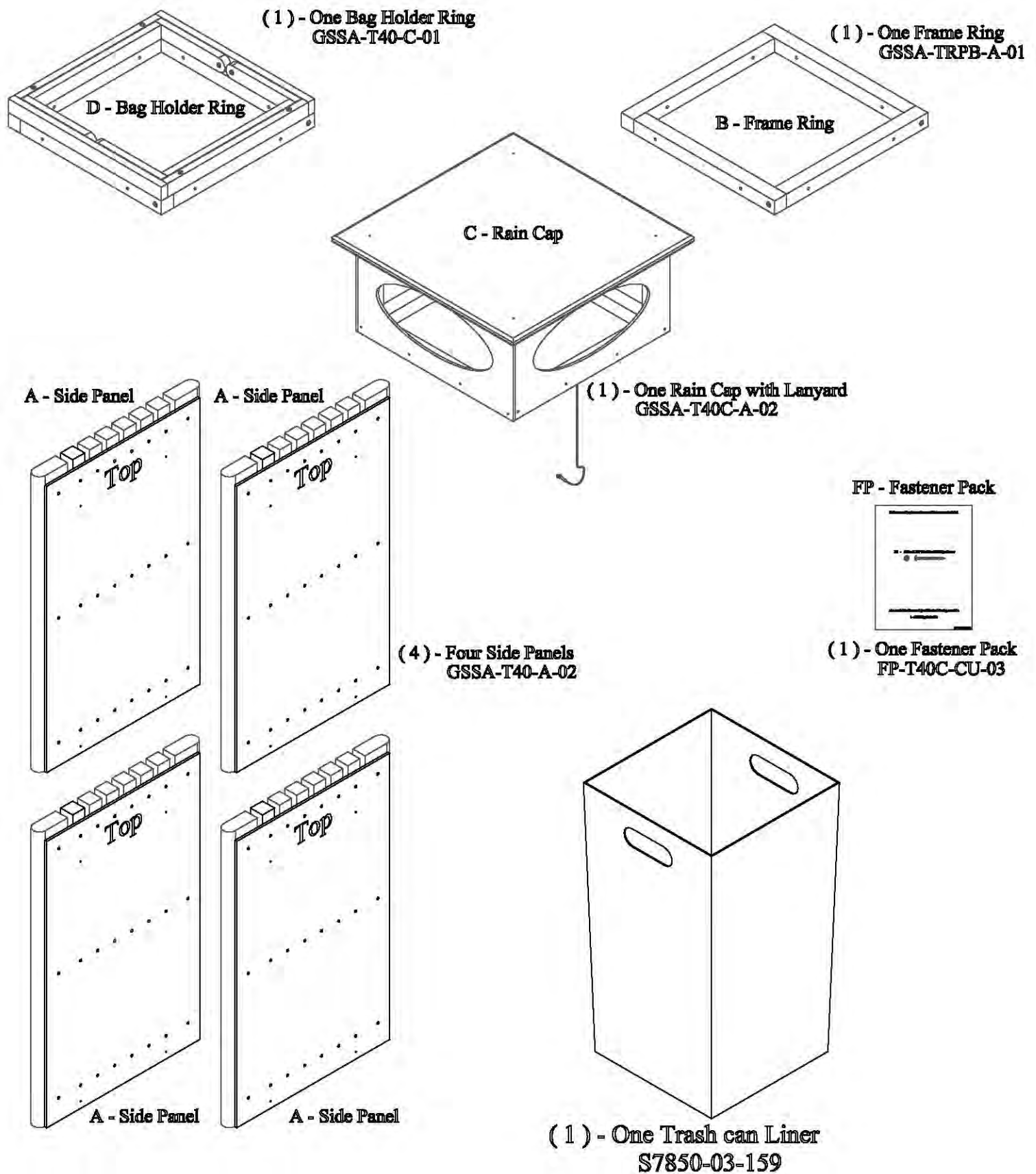

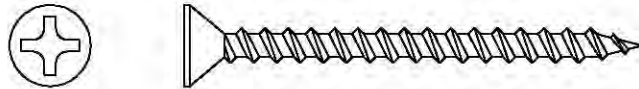

16 - #12 x 2 1/2" Flat Head Phillips Screw



1 - #12 x 1" Pan Head Phillips Screw

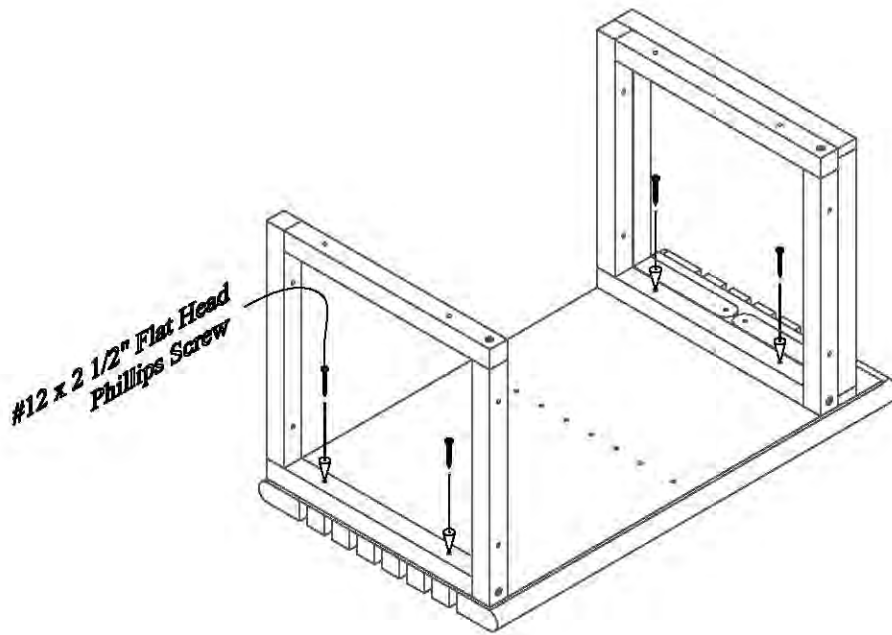


Also needed for this assembly will be the following materials:

1 - #3 Phillips Drive Bit

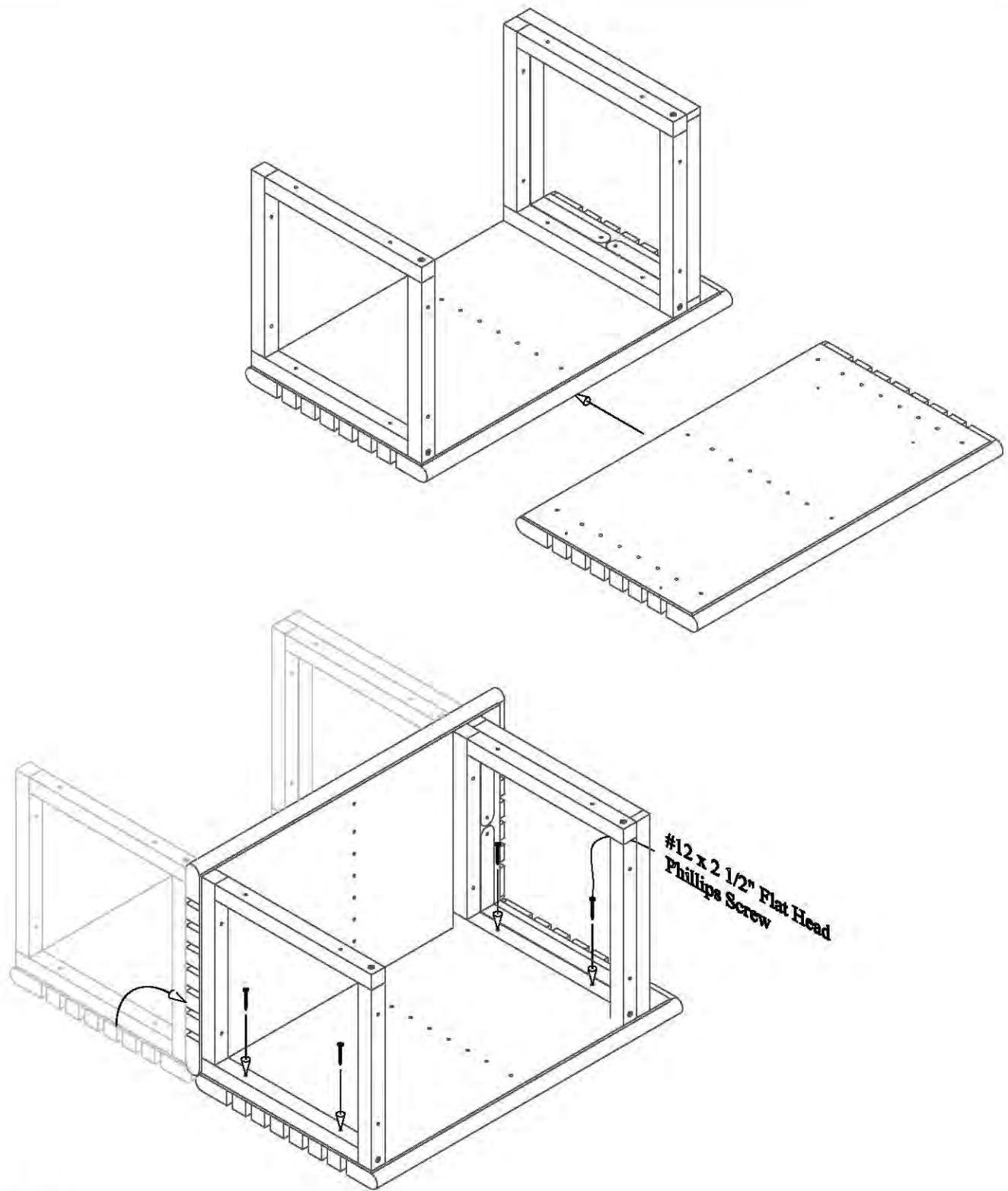
***IMPORTANT NOTICE*:**

- * DO NOT OVER-TIGHTEN SCREWS.
- * USE A DRILL WITH ADJUSTABLE TORQUE FOR BEST RESULTS.
- * OVER-TIGHTENING MAY RESULT IN STRIPPING OUT THE PILOT HOLE, AND SCREW MAY "SINK" INTO THE PLASTIC WHICH MAY CAUSE A STRESS FRACTURE.



Step #1:

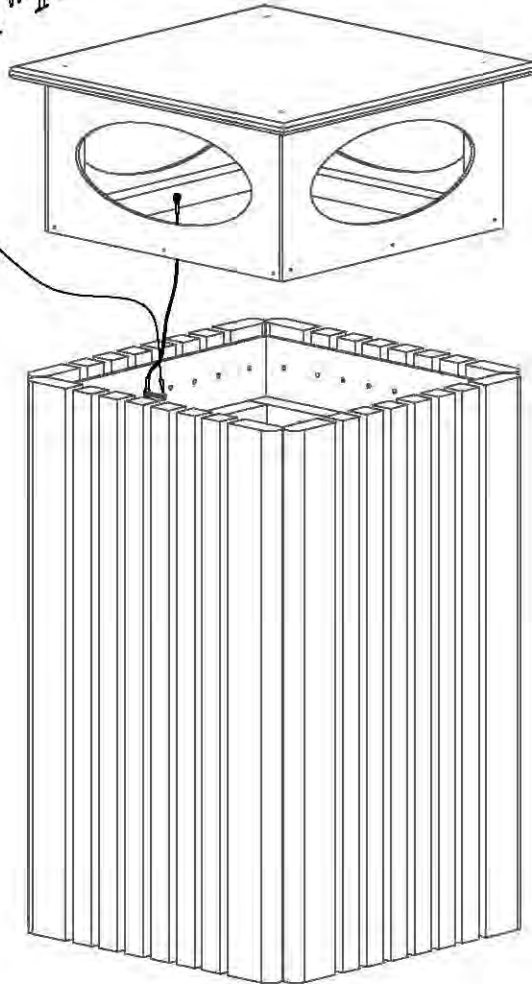
Lay a Side Panel as shown. Place the Bag Holder Ring at the top of the panel as shown in the above diagram. Place the Frame Ring at the bottom of the panel. Making sure the holes line up with the pre-drilled pilot holes in the panel. Fasten using (1) one 2-1/2" pan head screw per hole. Repeat for the bottom of the panel.



Step #2:

Place another Side Panel beside the previous panel so that it touches as displayed in the diagram above. Gently turn the side panel with the rings installed onto the new side panel. Making sure the holes line up with the pre-drilled pilot holes in the panel. Fasten using (1) one 2-1/2" flat head phillips screw per hole. Repeat this step for the rest of the Side Panels.

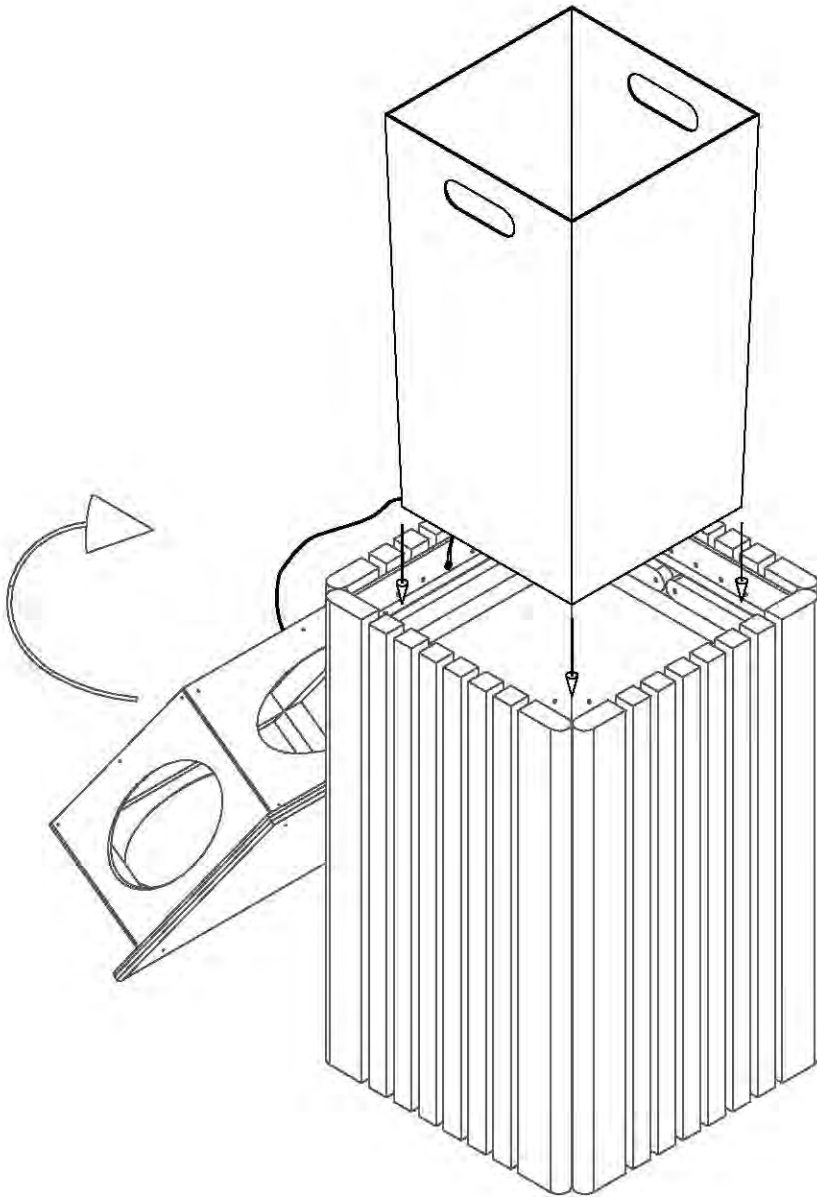
Remove a screw from the top row and replace it with the supplied #12 x 1" Pan Head Phillips Screw



Step #3:

Turn the trash receptacle upright onto its base. Please use caution while moving. At this point in assembly the receptacle will weigh approximately 145 pounds. Remove one of the screws from the top row of screws and swap it out for the supplied #12 x 1" Pan Head Phillips Screw. Secure it with the lanyard eyelet captured by the screw.

ATTN: This cap is not meant to hang. Use caution when removing the cap and carefully place it on the ground. If you don't want to take advantage of the supplied lanyard, simply remove the screw attaching it to the cap.



Step #4:

Place the Trash liner inside the base as shown. Carefully flip the cap onto the base letting it rest on the inner edge of the side panels.
