

Setup and usage of the Groom-Pro Pet Tub – Grooming Station

Use caution while assembling. Ask a partner for assistance.

- 1) Open the lid and remove the 4 legs and door
- 2) Flip the tub over or on its side and insert a leg into each recess. Gently use a rubber mallet to tap legs if necessary.
- 3) Rotate the tub onto its legs. Use caution when doing so.
- 4) If desired, attach a drain hose to the threaded valve located on the underside of the base.
- 5) The Pet Tub is now ready for use. Open the lid and place your pet inside.
- 6) When placing a pet inside, either lift them into the tub, or lift out the door to allow them to step in.
- 7) You can also secure pets to the tub using the included D-clip, located at the back-center of the tub. Either use a clipping leash to directly attach to the D-clip (recommended) or loop the leash around the D-clip. Adjust the leash to desired length.
- 8) When placing a pet on top of the tub for grooming, be sure the door is in place and the lid is all the way down.

Maintenance

- Dirt and debris can be rinsed from the surface using water and soap or detergent
- Never fill the tub with water as it is not a sealed unit
- When storing, ensure the tub is dry
- For added security, place rubber mats on the tub surface for improved traction. Be sure not to cover the drain when doing so.

WARNING! Always use caution when placing pets in the tub and never leave them unsupervised. Do not allow pets to become tangled on the D-clip leash hook as this can pose a choking hazard. Do not let children play in or around tub. Wet surfaces may pose a slipping hazard. Good Ideas will not be held responsible for any injuries sustained when using the Groom-Pro Pet Tub.
